THE COMPANY

Félix Solís Avantis is the holding responsible for the logistics and commercialization of the wineries belonging to Félix Solís Bodegas S.L and Pagos del Rey, S.L.

Bodegas Felix Solis SL has its own wineries in DO Valdepeñas and DO La Mancha; while Pagos del Rey, S.L. is present in DO Rueda, DO Ribera del Duero, DO Toro and in the DOC (top-quality wine region) Rioja.

Félix Solís Avantis dates back to 1952, and it is still a family-owned business, being the proprietors the four Solis brothers -Félix, Pedro, Juan Antonio y Manuel-. In addition to its DO wines (Rioja, Ribera del Duero, Rueda, Valdepeñas and La Mancha), it also specialises in wines classified as Vinos de la Tierra, Vinos de la Tierra Viñedos de España, table wines, sparkling wines, grape juices and sangrias, which are sold in almost eighty countries thanks to the extensive office network that has been established in several parts of the world

In addition to this, the company has its own winery since 1998 in Shanghai (China), it also boasts logistic and commercial facilities in other countries including Japan, the USA, the Czech Republic, France, the UK and Germany. According to an article published in the British magazine ISWR in 2005, Félix Solís Avantis is one of the World Top- Ten of still wine wineries.

FELIX SOLIS AVANTIS ORIGIN

The company was established in the fifties by Félix Solís Fernández. The turnover in 2007 was around 145 millions euros, this turnover put the company in the ranking of the most important wineries in Spain and one of the largest DO wine's exporters. Therefore, the company represents more than 60% of the exports in DO Valdepeñas.

In the fifties, the father of the current proprietors moved in to Valdepeñas and he realised that it was a good place for the wine business. Then, he bought a winery and he associated with some wine- producers. Afterwards, he bought a bottling plant in Madrid, which made it possible to create a distribution network in the capital of Spain.

In 1968, the Regulating Council for DO Valdepeñas was created and it imposed the obligation to produce and bottle wines in their place of origin. As a result, the company moved the bottling plant to Valdepeñas.

In the seventies, the company moved in to the current location (in central Spain). From then, the company has undergone several transformations, and nowadays it is one of the best wineries in Europe, with a capacity production of more than 300 million bottles of wine in one single plant

Besides, from 2001 the company boasts the largest automatic and air-conditioned wine warehouse in Europe, with the capacity of storing eighteen million bottles, a figure which it intends to increase till thirty million bottles

After the inauguration of the bottling plant in Shanghai, the company started the project called "Pagos del Rey SL", expecting to be present in the most renowned Appellations of Origin in Spain. As the result, Pagos del Rey winery was inaugurated in 2002 in Ribera del Duero . The winery is located in Olmedillo de Roa, a small village in Burgos, in the heart of the Ribera del Duero. Besides, the Solis family has emotional and personal links to this region.

In 2005, the company bought the winery "Castillo de Mudéjar" in Rueda (Valladolid), where three millions bottles will be bottled in the near future. The winery had to expand his capacity due to the increasing demand of its white wines.

The last link in the chain of Pagos del Rey was closed in 2005, when the first harvest was carried out in the winery of Pagos del Rey in DOC Rioja.

Besides in 2004, as Félix Solís, S.A, purchased the old winery "Bodega del Nieto". Today this winery, commercializes DO La Mancha wines, Vinos de la Tierra de Castilla and table wines, and it is currently undergoing extensive renovation. The renovation project with an investment of over twelve million euros will serve to enlarge the facilities and renew all the winemaking machinery and automatic fermentation tanks, as well as the equipment used for bottling.

The company, always trying to keep his family structure, has purchased in 2008 a new winery in DO Toro (Viña Bajoz).

On the other hand, they are weighing up the possibility of buying a winery in some “New world” country (Australia, Chile, South Africa or New Zealand)

LEGENDARY BRANDS

This development and expansion has been possible, above all, thanks to its legendary brands such as Viña Albali and Los Molinos. Those two brands have been in the top ten of the best selling wines in Spain. In the last information published by Sibaritas Magazine (Grupo Peñín), three wines of Felix Solís Avantis are in the ranking of the “Ten best selling wines in Spain” (Los Molinos Joven, sold 14.4 million bottles, and it is the first one; Viña Albali reserva, sold 9 million bottles, and it is the third one; and, Altos de Tamarón Joven, sold 2.6 million bottles and it’s in the tenth place).

Felix Solis SA is the winery that gathers in more red grapes, besides, if we refer to the technology and commercialization, it is one of the most important wineries in the world.

In Ribera del Duero, Pagos del Rey, which started its first harvest in 2002, is one of the third most important wineries in this Appellation of Origin; and, in Rueda, Blume is the second best- selling brand.

PIONEERING IN THE CONQUEST OF INTERNATIONAL MARKETS

At the beginning of the seventies, Felix Solis supplied wines to the German emigrants and the Spanish consumers in Ceuta, Melilla and Sahara. Those first experiences have laid the foundations of its enterprising character.

Nowadays, the Grand Son of the founder, Félix Solís Ramos is the International Manager of the company and he coordinates the Activities of 6 Area Managers that work from Spain and more than 30 people in the subsidiaries of China, France, Czech Republic, Germany, Japan, and the U.S. He is also directly responsible of the business of its participated company in the UK called Free Run Wines.

The International part of the business is growing year after year and at the end of 2008 it will represent more than 50% of the total turnover of the company, coming from 40% in 2006 and 45% in 2007. Our expectations are that it will continue growing up to more than 70% of the total turnover in the coming 5 years. The reason is mainly the

stagnation of the domestic consumption of wine and the growth of the consumption in foreign countries, mainly coming from Asia, America, Eastern Europe and Africa.

The Export Market is very important for the company as the product handled is of higher profile than average. The main quality brand of the company, Viña Albali is selling more than 1,2 MM cases of 9 liters of wine worldwide and is one of the top quality Spanish Wine Brands sold worldwide.

Félix Solís is positioning itself as a “global supplier” of Spanish wines, being able to deliver wines from the most important appellations in Spain from one single point. The Quality-Price relationship of its products, the understanding of the International Trade and the Service are the three Stones in which the business is founded.

COMMERCIAL NETWORK

In 2007, our wines were sold a 55% in the domestic market and 45 % in the international market. More than 150 sales persons sell the wide range of products of Felix Solis Avantis every day, in Spain and all over the world.

The distribution is carried out through a wide commercial network, which has branches and warehouses in the most important cities in Spain.

Another strong point of Felix Solis Avantis is its wide range of products and brands (Viña Albali, Albali Arium, Los Molinos, Altos de Tamarón, Condado de Oriza, Analivia, Blume, Marqués de Altillo, El Circulo, Arnegui, Castillo de Soldepeñas, Diego de Almagro, Sendas del Rey, Castillo del Moral, Peñasol, Castañeda, Cruzares, Bajoz, Caño, etc)

INTERNATIONAL SUBSIDIARIES

FÉLIX SOLÍS FRANCE, S.A.R.L.

It is in charge of the distribution and commercialization in France. It was inaugurated in the nineties and since 2005 it has new facilities. .

FÉLIX SOLÍS CZ A.S.

It was established in Prague in the year 1999, and this subsidiary acts as a channel of distribution for Czech Republic, Slovak Republic, Poland and Hungary markets.

Besides, the company has a warehouse to distribute the wines in that area, The company is nowadays the largest importer of bottled wine in this country with more than 13 million litres of wine sold.

FREE RUN WINES LIMITED

This joint venture was set up in 2001 in United Kingdom with local partners. Free Run Wines is in charge of the sales and marketing of wine for Felix Solis Avantis group in this region, with more than 15 million bottles sold in the market in 2008. Through Free Run Wines all our wines are distributed to United Kingdom and Ireland.

FÉLIX SOLIS GMBH

This German subsidiary was established in 2005, trying to boost the exports to one of the most important markets in Europe. Since its establishment, the company has grown more than 70% in this large market, making Viña Albali one of the two main Spanish brands in this country.

FÉLIX SOLIS USA

A new representative office has been opened in June of 2008. It is located in New York city. This subsidiary acts as a channel of penetration in this market, as it is potentially a very interesting market for the company.

FÉLIX SOLIS JAPAN

This representative office was set up in 2007. Nowadays, Félix Solís avantis is on the second place in the ranking of the Spanish wineries that commercialize its wines in Japan. The company sold 61.700 cases of 12 bottles during the year 2007.



SHANGHAI FÉLIX SOLÍS WINERY CO., LTD.

This joint-venture is located in Shanghai and it was established in 1998. The main objective of this winery is to supply the Chinese market.

Felix Solis Avantis was pioneering in the wine sector, when the Shanghai Felix Solis Winery Co was set up. This project was placed in the city of Huangdu (Jiading district). There are a winery and a bottling plant whose production capacity is more than 10 million bottles per year.

DO VALDEPEÑAS

This winery, located in Valdepeñas, acts as the headquarters of the company. It has an extension of 120,000 m², fourteen bottle lines, with a capacity of more than 150,000 units per hour. The production plant is equipped with state-of-the-art technology

In this winery we can find the central offices and the warehouse where the wines are loaded and distributed. The total capacity of storage is 250,000 millions litres, including 60,000 American oak barrels.

With the main goal of being more competitive, from 2001 the winery boasts the largest automatic and air-conditioned wine warehouse in Europe.

Since 20 years ago, Viña Albali or Los Molinos are in the top of all “best-selling wines” rankings. Lately, the company is focusing on diversifying its range of products. So, the company has created the range of products “Albali Arium”, exclusively for the on-trade.

Besides, the winery distributes Vinos de la Tierra de Castilla (Orchestra, Consigna). Vinos de la Tierra- Viñedos de España (Peñasol and Soldepeñas), table wines, grape juices, sangría. Besides there will be a line of production with around 30 million litres of sparkling wines very soon.

PAGOS DEL REY, S.L.

The four wineries in DO Ribera del Duero, DO Rueda, DOC Rioja and DO Toro are under the name of Pagos del Rey SL. It is a project whose main objective is selling wines from the most renowned regions in Spain. This project was fulfilled in 2002, when the winery in Ribera del Duero was opened.

DO RIBERA DEL DUERO

Pagos del Rey winery in DO Ribera del Duero is located in Olmedillo de Roa (Burgos), just in the heart of Ribera del Duero. It was the beginning of the project, which was fulfilled when the first harvest took place in 2002.

Nowadays, the barrel cellar is made up of 8,000 oak barrels. The barrels are made out of American oak (80%) and French oak (20%).

The winery has a production capacity of 8 million litres, although, during the first years, the production has been around 5 millions. Besides, the bottle line's output is 8,000 bottles per hour.

Altos de Tamarón, in the off-trade channel, and Condado de Oriza, for the off-trade channel, are the main brands in DO Ribera del Duero. According to the sales ranking of DO Ribera del Duero brands in Spain's retail market, Altos de Tamarón joven and crianza are two of the best selling wines in Spain.

This village gives its name to the Appellation of Origin, known for the quality of its white wines. Verdejo is the most important variety in this DO and it is the synonym of quality in white winemaking.

Since 2004, this winery has doubled its production capacity and now commercializes mainly two brands: Blume (off-trade) and Analivia (on-trade). According to the sales ranking of DO Rueda brands in Spain's retail market, Blume Verdejo and Rueda are the third best selling wines in Spain.

It is certainly one of Spain’s most promising regions for the production of powerful quality red wines.

When he was 18, he started to work in the winery that had been established by his father, Félix Solís Fernández. Afterwards, he moved in to Madrid , and he started to be in charge of the bottling plant and the local office. He was pioneer in exporting wines from Valdepeñas to Germany, Ceuta and Melilla. He has worked in several areas in the company, above all in sales department. Nowadays he is the president and managing director of Felix Solis SA (DO Valdepeñas and La Mancha wineries) and Pagos del Rey SL (DO Rueda, DO Ribera, DOC Rioja wineries).

During the time he has been working as managing director the company has carried out several changes and transformations. Nowadays the company is one of the best in terms of capacity, technology and facilities, being the most important winery of Spain in terms of D.O wines exports. According to an article published in the British magazine ISWR in 2005, Félix Solís Avantis is in the World Top- Ten of still wine wineries, and the most important winery in Spain.

Besides, several subsidiaries have been set up in France, China, Czech Republic, Germany, UK, Japan, USA and they are weighing up the possibility of buying a winery in a “New world” country (Chile, New Zealand, South Africa)

Felix Solís Yáñez has taken part of several conferences and seminars. Nowadays, he is the president of the “Association of winemakers in DO Valdepeñas” and he is a member of the “Spanish Federation of the wine”, “Castilla La Mancha Tierra de Viñedos”, ASEVICAMAN, and “Family-owned business Institute”. He has been member of the Regulatory Council in Valdepeñas.

On the other hand, he has been awarded as “Business man of the decade” by the newspaper ABC in Castilla la Mancha.
